Petition of Administrator of P. Ellice Administrator of all and singular the goods and
of Isaac Ellice for Chattels right and credits which were of Isaac Ellice late of
Orange Township in the said County deceased at the time of
his death who was intestate. Was preferred to the Court Humbly
shewing. That the said Intestate died April 19. AD 1846. that letters of
Administration were granted and issued to your petitioner 26 May AD 1846. by
the Register of Probate for said County of Columbia. That the personal Estate
of said Intestate is insufficient for the payment of his debts as by the statement

Eighteen acres one hundred perches and allowance and having a Dist

North by other lands of the aforesaid decedent, and by lands of George Ellice
