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## WILLIAM HEDGES Who gave his life for his country, in the AMERICAN REVOLUTION, 1777.

The record which follows this narrative is that of William Hedges, Jr., who took smallpox during the Revolution, in camp, and went home to die a short while later, of the disease. It is possible that his older brother, Joseph Hedges, who witnessed William Hedges' Will, took the disease and died of it also. Joseph Hedges' Will was probated on the same day as was that of the younger brother, William Hedges. William Hedges' second son, John, is heard from no more after being mentioned in his father's Will, so he, too, may have died of smallpox. At any rate, he was not living when the estate of William Hedges was finally settled in 1782, (probably when the widow, Elizabeth, married again—to a man named Smith—probably Philip Smith, tho the first name has not at this time been proved to be that).

The date of birth of William Hedges is gleaned from his father's Will, which was made Aug. 11, 1742, and probated Jan. 29, 1742/3, and from the purchase and division of the tract of land called "Hedge Hogg." Copies of all three Wills mentioned, and the Deeds mentioned, are included in this work. All available records have been copied and included, to facilitate checking.

William Hedges, Jr. (of the Revolution) had four children:
1. Andrew Hedges, m.lst, Christena Cramer;
m. 2nd, Julianna Leatherman.

2. John Hedges, who died as a child.

3. William Hedges, III, who is said to have gone to Philadelphia, and no further record is found to date.

4. Levi Hedges, m. Rosanah Ribelin, and d. Fleming Co., Kentucky.

As Levi Hedges was born Nov. 24, 1775, he was under two years old when his father died, and if his older brother, John, died at the same time, it is quite understandable that Levi would not remember John. Levi Hedges' son, Wm. Ribelin Hedges, who wrote to his daughter-in-law during the Civil War, apparently never had heard of the brother of his father, namely, John. (See photostat of letter, included.) -pp. 29, 30.

Andrew Hedges' marriage to his first wife, Christena Cramer is given as April 30, 1792, but as digits are hard to decipher, it probably was 1791. His second marriage, to Julianna Leatherman was Jan. 29, 1805. His descendants all are from the only son who survived to marry, namely, Enos Hedges. (A descendant says he spelled his name that way, in spite of the fact that his Will appears to be signed "Feneas" Hedges. There was an Enos family in the Swedish community of Christina (now Wilmington) Delaware whence this family appears to have come, from New Castle, Del. (Whether they were in Maryland before going to New Castle, as appears probable, has not been proved, to date.)

Andrew Hedges was made guardian to his two younger brothers in 1792. One searcher gave the date as 1791, and another 1797, but Levi Hedges was in Kentucky before 1797, and closer inspection gave the date Apr. 12, 1792.

Levi Hedges, youngest child of Lieut. WILLIAM HEDGES of the REVOLUTION went to Kentucky, exact date not proven, but probably in 1795. He was found in Montgomery Co., Ky., in 1797, as also was Mathias Hedges (Levi's first cousin, son of Joseph Hedges, d. 1777). Levi Hedges probably married Rosanah Ribelin in 1795, as the legend in the family states that she was only fourteen years old at marriage and her father, William Ribelin, enranged at her marriage, threatened to scratch her name from the family Bible. As Rosanah was b. Sept. 2, 1780, so was 15 on Sept. 2, 1795, her marriage date probably was prior to Sept. 2, 1795. (If Wm. Ribelin scratched the name from the Bible, he didn't do a good job of it, as the record at the Kentucky Historical Society at Lexington, includes her name with the other children.) Since Levi would not be twenty years old till Nov. 24, 1795, he must have been only 19 years old at marriage.

Levi Hedges and his wife, Rosanah (Ribelin) Hedges, lie buried in the Graham Cemetery, on the Cornelius Turner farm, .9 mile S. and .2 mile east of Poplar Plains, Kentucky. The date had been erroneously copied by some chapter of D.A.R. (I was told) the death of Levi being given in that list as 1817. He died, however, April 1, 1847, and chalk on the stone brings out the date more clearly. The Compiler took photographs of both stones and they are included in this work. Two Flemingsburg H.S. boys went with Compiler to hunt for the graves, and they were located completely covered with earth. The photographs were made Nov. 23, 1950.

William Hedges, Jr., was Lieut. of 4th Co., 33rd Pattalion, Maryland Militia. (Maryland Historical Magazine, Vol. IV, p.380.) At Basking Ridge, East New Jersey, on March 3, 1777, that company was "not yet discharged." In the rank and file of that company was William Hedges' half-brother, John Julian (given here "Julan"), son of William Hedges' mother, Ann, by her second husband, Stephen Julian, to whom she had been married July 14, 1743 (Reformed Church record). Why the company was "not yet dismissed" is not stated. The members may have been nearing completion of the time of a "tour" as the period of service was called, or the ranks may have been so depleted by smallpox and the remainder of the men so sick from the disease that they were nearly ready to be sent home. It will be observed in the letter of William Hedges' grandson (already cited) "When (we were) in the Revolution, he joined the army and took the small pocks and went home and died." The letter quoted from, has a postscript by Compiler's grandmother, Samantha Jane (Vawter) Hedges.

We are deeply indebted for this letter, to Mary Ann (Vawter) Hedges, wife of Peter Thompson Hedges, who was the son of William Ribelin Hedges. Mary Ann was the sister of Samantha Jane, both being daughters of Pascal Vawter and his wife, Eliza (Mavity) Vawter. Samantha's husband was Levi Marion Hedges, brother of Peter Thompson Hedges, mentioned above. The reason that Samantha was at "Papy Hedges" was that her husband, as well as that of Mary Ann, was away in the Civil War at that time. Mary Ann had taken her little son, Thaddeus, then four years old, with her to Bryantsburg, Ind. (now Bryant, Ind.) to teach school while her husband was at war.

Fearing that her husband and that of her sister, Samantha, might be killed in battle, Mary Ann appealed to her father-in-law, to tell her what he could of the Hedges family. That her wish was urgent, is evidenced by the fact that when she got no reply to her first appeal, she wrote again. The original of this letter (the reply to her request) was in the possession of Ida (Hedges) Cronkhite, dau. of Mary Ann (Vawter) and her husband, Peter Thompson Hedges. She is now deceased, and the letter probably is in the possession of Flora Tillotson, at Center Point, Iowa, since that is where Ida Cronkhite was living at the time of her death. When the war troubles became very threatening to them personally, Wm. Ribelin Hedges and his wife, Malinda, and their daughter-in-law, Samantha, went to Aberdeen, Ohio just across the river from Maysville, Ky., to wait out the war. Here the 4th child of Samantha and her husband, Levi Marion Hedges (Mary Addison, called "Addie") was born.

The "Thaddus" who is admonished by his grandfather to be a "good boy and learn his book" is now (1955) 96 years old. He taught school a few years and then became a minister in the Christian Church. Compiler's mother, Mary Mildred (Wear) went to Wingard School, with Thaddeus Hedges as her teacher, and later the man to whom she was to be married—Ashba Vawter Hedges (son of Levi Marion Hedges) also was her teacher in that school. The term following that she had as her teacher, "Blanche" Hedges, sister of Thaddeus Hedges. Blanche Hedges taught again during the teacher shortage during World War II. A grade card made out to Mary Wear by Blanche Hedges, was kept by her all thru the years till her death in 1945. Compiler did not get to see Blanche Hedges, but has seen Thaddeus Hedges many times and visited in his home.

Ashba Vawter Hedges (called "A. V." or "Vawter") began his school teaching in Kentucky at the age of eighteen years, having attended high school at Hillsboro, Ky. He taught a few terms in Illinois, the last being the year following his marriage. In the fall of 1892 A. V. Hedges and his wife moved to Kansas, where he was teacher, and superintendent of schools for more than thirty-five years. All of his children were born in Kansas, except the first, which died at birth. Mr. Hedges' oldestathree children, as well as his brothers Edgar, John, and Walter, went to school to him. The three named brothers, as well as their sister, Lida, lived with A. V. and Mrs. Hedges for a number of years. Levi Marion Hedges, the youngest child of the family was reared by his uncle and aunt, Peter Thompson Hedges and Mary Ann (Vawter) Hedges.

Mary Mildred (Wear) was the daughter of James Almon Wear and his first wife, Mary Amanda Indiana (Murray). She was born Sept. 4, 1874 at Perrysville, Indiana, on the Wabash River, and died April 25, 1945, at Hays, Kansas. She was one of ten children, seven of whom grew up. Her twin brother, Allan, died when they were ten years old. Mary (Wear) Hedges taught school the year her daughter, Mary, started to school, and was her teacher.

A. V. Hedges is buried in Maple Grove Cemetery, Wichita, Kans., and Mary Mildred (Wear) Hedges is buried in Mt. Allen Cemetery, Hays, Kansas.

Levi Marion Hedges died at the home of his daughter, Lida (Hedges) Gill, at Topeka, Kans., and is buried in the Topeka Cemetery. His first wife, Samantha Jane (Vawter) Hedges is buried in the Emberry Cem., north of Muncie, Ill. Samantha was the mother of all of the children. Levi and Samantha sold their farm in Rowan Co., Ky. in 1879, and moved the family to Vermillion Co., Illinois. Peter Thompson Hedges had moved his family to Illinois in 1864, near what is now Fithian, where they lived for thirty-one years. They moved about 1911, to Canton, Mo., where both P. T. and Mary Ann are buried.

William Ribelin Hedges, father of Peter Thompson Hedges, and of Levi Marion Hedges (and many others) is buried on a hill out about 6.5 miles beyond the railroad station marked "Farmer" Kentucky. This cemetery is called "Three Lick." It is quite a large burying ground, tho many of the graves there were marked only by wooden headpieces, which are crumbling to ruin, and no longer legible. The Hedges stones are just outside the fence-enclosed Ingram plot. William Ribelin Hedges was one of the twelve children of Levi Hedges and Rosanah (Ribelin) all of whom are said to have grown up. (There may have been two or three others who d. as infants, or as children.) Malinda R., wife of Wm. Ribelin Hedges, is said to have been Malinda Russell Cassity, but the proof of the middle name has not been found by Compiler to date.

All had descent except the youngest, "Ike" Hedges.

In the "Three Lick" Cemetery, the grave enclosed by a rock wall, on the same location as that of Wm. R.'s and Malinda R.'s stones, probably is that of their oldest daughter, Mary Ann (Hedges) Crouch, tho no headstone is there. A letter from Melissa Hedges to her brothers at the time of her father's death said that their father had been buried near the grave of "sister Mary," and it is probable that "Uncle Billy" as he was called by others in after life, had his sons carry the rock up for her grave enclosure. The home of "Uncle Billy" and "Aunt Linda" is a large hewn-log house now occupied (1951) by Ollie Swim, and is 4.7 miles beyond the R.R. station of "Farmer," Kentucky.

Will of WILLIAM HEDGES, d.1742/3 Frederick Co., Maryland (then, Prince George Co.)

"In the Name of God, Amen. The <a href="Ll day of August">Ll day of August</a>, 1742, I William Hedges of the County of Prince Georges in Maryland, farmer, being very sick and weak in body, but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be given unto God therefor, calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say, Principally and First of all I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of God that gave it and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian buriall at the discretion of my Executors, not doubting but at the generall resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased Almighty God to Bless me in this life, I give, devise and bequeath of the same in the following manner and form.

"Imprimis. I give and bequeath to Ann my dearly beloved wife, the thirds of all my moveables and to live on my Estate during the life of my son.

"Item. I give to my son, Loseph, all my Lands together with all the rest of Goods, Debts and moveable Effects.

"Item. I give my two daughters fifteen pounds apiece current money of Maryland to be paid when my son, Joseph, is of age and one breeding mare apiece at my decease with there Colts and there increase from the date hereof.

"Item. I give to my 4.child that my wife is now great with, if a son, the half of my Land and if a daughter, in proportion with the rest."

"This Indenture made the fifteenth day of March seventeen hundred and sixty three between Jacob Kneff of Frederick County and Province of Maryland Heir at Law to Jacob Kneff of Prince Georges County and Province afs. Deceased of the one part and Joseph Hedges and William Hedges of Frederick County and Province afs. Sons and Heirs of WILLIAM HEDGES of Prince Georges County and Province afs. of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jacob Kneff for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Fifty pounds Currency to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Hedges and William Hedges before the ensealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold Aliend Transferred and made over and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell Alien Transfer and make over unto the said Joseph Hedges and William Hedges their heirs and Assigns forever all that tract of land called HEDGE HOGG, lying and being in Frederick County aforesaid (Their Mothers thirds of the aforesaid Land to be due to her for and during her Natural Life without any Molestation or Debarrance whatsoever from or under them or their heirs and Assigns).

"Beginning at a bounded Beetch standing by Monococy river near the end of the sixteenth Line of Esqr. Taskers land and running thence Viz. 9) North four degrees West thirty perches, (2) then North twenty degrees West thirty perches (3) then North twelve degrees West forty perches, 69 then North three degrees West thirty four perches, 69 then North twenty two degrees West twenty perches, 6 then North nine degrees East forty perches (7) then North seven degrees West Thirty four perches, (%) then North twenty eight degrees West twenty four perches. (7) then North forty degrees West sixty eight perches (19) then South eighty four degrees West eighty four perches, (11) then South twenty seven degrees West one hundred perches (12) then South Twenty four degrees East one hundred and forty perches [3] then South seventy seven degrees East fifty two perches (4) then South twenty six degrees East sixteen perches, ('5) then South twenty five degrees West forty eight perches (14) then by a Straight Line to the beginning, Containing Two Hundred and Fifty Eight Acres of land more or less, Together with all Houses Buildings Improvements and all other appurtenances thereto belonging, to Have and to Hold the said land & premisses with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto them the said Joseph Hedges and William Hedges their Heirs and Assigns forever (Their Mothers Thirds excepted as before excepted) And the said Jacob Neff for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators doth covenant ang agree to and with the said Joseph Hedges and William Hedges their heirs and Assigns that he the said Jacob Kneff his heirs Executors and Administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend the said land and premisses unto them the said Joseph Hedge and William Hedges their

heirs and Assigns from all and every person and persons whatsoever that shall or may hereafter Claim any right Title or interest of in and to the same or any part thereof from by or under him and also shall and will at the request and at the Cost and Charges in the law of the said Joseph Hedges and William Hedges their heirs and Assigns at any time hereafter make acknowledge suffer and execute any other Deed or Instrument of writing that the said Joseph and William Hedge or his or their Counsel Learnt in the law shall or may reasonably Advise devise or require for the further and better Assurance surety and suremaking of all and singular the said land and premisses unto them the said Joseph Hedges and William Hedges their heirs and Assigns forever Provided always that such other Deed or Instrument of writing that the said Joseph Hedges and William Hedges or their heirs or Assigns or their Counsel Learnt in the law shall or may reasonably Advise devise or require by another Warrantee than is Intended by the above Instrument of writing in Witness whereof the said Jacob Kneff hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day and Year above Written.

County & province of Maryland aforesaid Tanner of the one part & Wm. Hedges of the same place, farmer, of the other part Whereas by Indenture of Bargain & Sale bearing date on or about the fifteenth day of March which was in the year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred & fifty three & made or mentioned to be made between Jacob Kneff of Fredk. County & province of Maryland heir at Law of Jacob Kneff of Prince Georges County & province afs. deceased of the one part and the said Joseph Hedges & Wm. Hedges parties to these presents of the other part he the said Jacob Kneff for the Considerations therein mentioned Did grant bargain alien Transfer & make over unto the said Joseph Hedges & Wm. Hedges their Heirs & Assigns all that Tract of Land called Hedge Hogg lying & being in Fredk. County aforesaid/ their mothers thirds of the aforesaid Land to be due to her for and during her Natural life without any molestation or debarrance whatsoever from or under them their Heirs & assigns beginning at a bounded beech standing by Monoquizy river near the end of the sixteenth line of Esquire Taskers Land & running thence Vizt."

(There followed a description of the property--and many pages of the greatest bombast it has ever been my priviledge to peruse.) -M.N.R.note. "Sealed & deliv. in the presence of W. Price, Chrs. Edelin" and each of the men paid five shillings for the recording of the deed.

"Memorandum on the 17 of June 1772 then was the within deed acknowledged by the within named Joseph Hedges & Wm. Hedges, partys thereto according to act of assembly and at the same time Mary the Wife of the said Jos. Hedges being examined apart from her said Husband declared that she relinquished all her right & claim of Dower of in and to the said southermost part of the sd Tract of Land called Hedge Hogg and that she did the same freely & voluntarily & was not Induced or Compelld thereto by Coertion of her sd. Husband or for fear of his displeasure and at the same time also Elizabeth the wife of the sd. Wm. Hedges being examined apart from her said Husband declared that she relinquished all right & claim of Dower of in and to the said Northermost part of the said Tract of Land called Hedge Hogg and that she did the same freely & voluntarily & was not induced or Compelled thereto by Coertion of her said Husband or for fear of his displeasure."

"In the Name of God Amen. I William Hedges of Frederick County of Province of Maryland, being weak of Body but of perfect Mind and memory, thanks be given therefore, calling to mind the Uncertainty of this life, and that it is appointed for all Men once to die, do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament in manner of Form following. Viz.: I give and recommend my Soul into the Hands of almighty God that gave it and my Body to the Earth to be buried in a Christianlike and decent Manner at the Discretion of my Executors herein after named.

"Imprimis: I give and bequeath unto my wife, Elizabeth, the Plantation whereon I now live, being one Moiety or half part of a Tract of Land called Hedge Hog, containing one hundred and twentynine acres, and also my moveable Estate of what Nature or kind so ever during the Term or Time she remains my Widow, but in case she should marry before my Son Andrew should arrive to the age of twenty-one years, It is my Will and I do order that the said Plantation or half-part of the Tract aforesaid be rented out for the highest Price that can be got for the same, and the Money to be paid to my Sons, Andrew, John, William, and Levi, equally divided share and share alike, as they respectively arrive to the age of twenty-one years, my wife, Elizabeth, her thirds excepted, both in Real and personal Estate notwithstanding.

"Item: It is my Will and I do order that my Children, namely, I Andrew, 2 John, 3 William and K Levi, be bound by my Executors, unto such Trades as they shall choose, when they respectively arrive to the age of fifteen years with a proviso in each of their indentures for the Person to whom they are bound to learn them to read and write and cast accompts to suit such Trade, and also to find them sufficient Meat, Drink, Washing, Apparel, lodging and physic.

The 26th day of April in the year of our  $L_0$ rd one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven, I, JOSEPH HEDGES of the county of Frederick in the Province of Maryland, farmer, being very sick and weak in Body, but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be given unto God therefore Calling unto Mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament.



#### Letter from Wm. Riblan Hedges, to Mary Ann (Vawter) Hedges:

"August 30, 1863.

"Dear Daughter:

"After so long [a] time neglecting to answer your first letter, we now have taken our pen to answer boath. We received yours of the 17 August, and heard your complaint of getting no answer. We think you have a right to complain, not knowing all of our troubles. It was not of any disrespect. About the time we should have wrote, the rebels was in, and there is so mutch confusion here, that no time we do not feel like we could compose a letter, and we do not want you to think hard of us on that account, but be assured it (is) not for want of respect we have neglected to write to you. And Peter -- we got a letter from him, requesting that Thompson should take the mare and to get the money that is in Howard's hands. We have not went as yet to see about it, but will go in a fiew days, and he will be bound to have a saddle, and if we do not get that money, we can't fit him out. The rebels took boath of my saddles so we tell you that we will do the best that we can, and as Malisa has wrote several times, she has give you the occurences of the neighbourhood.

"You requested to know about the Hedges family. My father said that there was 3 or 4 brothers landed at filadelphia and one of them went to verginia, and the rest—we do not remember where they went. Our grand father settled in merriland state, and when in the revolution, he joined the army and took the small pocks and went home and died. [New page begins.] His name was WILLIAM HEDGES. We had a[n] uncle name[d] Andrew. He lived on the old stand and died there in merriland. We had an uncle named William. He went to philadelphia and we never heard of him since. There was several cousins in Ohio, about 20 miles north east of Chillocotha. This is the best account we can give of the relations.

"And now, Maryann, as we have not bin prompt in answering yours, do not take the pouts and quit writeing to us. Remember that we are old and [have] many difficulties to incounter, for we every fiew days hear some threat, and some depredation from the rebels. We are told that they are comeing down after a while and the horses that they do not want, they will kill, so as you have some idea of our troubles, we bid you farewell, hopeing that if we meet no more in this world of trouble, we may live so that we may be prepared [to] meet where trouble never comes, and parting will be no more. Tell Thaddus to be [a] good boy and learn his book, and be good to his mother. Give our respects to grand father and mother Vawter, and all inquiring friends.

"We forgot to tell you that we had frost here this morning. It did not hurt any thing that we have seen."

Letter from Melissa Lucinda Hedges, to her brothers, Wm. R. Hedges, James A. Hedges, L. L. Hedges, and sister, Phy Hedges. ("Phy" was Philora (Allen) Hedges, but she must have slipped on the initials "L. L." as she must have meant Levi Marion Hedges.)

"At home, December 1, 1885.

"Dear Brothers and sisters: He was Wm. Ribelin Hedges ,\*

"It is with a sad heart I take up my pen to write the sad news of our dear father's death. He departed this life Saturday, Nov. 28, at 25 minutes after six o'clock in the morning. After a serious illness of 12 days [.] He suffered more than tongue can tell. He lay in an unconscious state for several hours. He suffered greatly from the time he was taken. The doctor had to draw his water from him. Oh it was so hard to see him suffer so, but it had to be. Rose came to see him; staid several days then went home; came back after he was down. Ike got here after he was dead. Uncle Jesse staid with him all the time. We laid him in the old graveyard where sister Mary was laid, there to slumber til Gabriel's trump and the voice of the Lord shall awaken the dead from the old churchyard.

"I sent postals to you all when I found he was so bad, but I suppose it was not so any of you could come. He never talked about any of his children, but thought he could not live from the start. We done all we could for him but nothing done any good. He has done paid the debt we all have to pay and we can go to him; he cannot come to us; Oh how we miss him. Mother sits around and looks so sad. I can hardly bear it. She is not well. She sends her love to you all.

"My love to you all. "rite soon as you all are very close together. I want this letter to be read by all. I would love to see you and talk to you face to face but we are far apart. Yes we are scattered—we are scattered, though a joyous band were we. Now this letter is for one and all of you. Write as often as you can.

Your sister, M. L. Stenrod."

The foregoing letter was in the possession of Anna (Hedges) Bagley, Purdin, Mo., when Mary (Hedges) Reiner visited her in 1940.

The following incident in the early life of Wm. Riblan Hedges, whose death is recounted above, is told by George Edward Hedges, son of James Alva Hedges and his wife, Philora (Allen). When "Willie Riblan" was about 10 years old, he shot and wounded a bear on or near the home place in Kentucky, but did not kill it. He ran to the house in excitement to get the dogs. Upon hearing what was afoot, his father, Levi Hedges, said he knew where the bear would go, and knew a short cut to the place, so he went with "Wilie Riblan" with his own gun, and intercepted the bear. He shot it, himself, and Willie was outraged, as it had been his bear, and he had not been allowed to polish it off.

I, Ida (Hedges) Cronkhite, do assert that the letter comprised of two pages, dated August 30, 1863, and signed "Wm. R. Hedges" and under that, "M. R. Hedges", a photostat of which appears herewith, came into my possession when we divided the keepsakes at my father's death in 1924.

The heading "At Home" would mean the home where Wm. R. and M. R. Hedges, his wife, lived on the "bank of the Licking River at the mouth of the Bluebank" Fleming Co., Kentucky, in the part of Fleming County later cut off toomake Rowan Co. Their postoffice address at that time was Hillsboro. The "dear daughter" addressed, was my mother, the wife of their second son, Peter Thompson Hedges (Capt. Co. G, 24th Ky.). At that date Capt. Hedges was in the south with Sherman on the campaign that ended for him when he was wounded on May 14, 1864, at Resaca, Georgia, and soon after, received honorable discharge for disability. His wife was teaching school in Indiana. Her address at that time was Bryantsburg, Ind.

The "Samantha" who added the postscript to the letter, was my mother's sister, Samantha Jane (Vawter) Hedges, whose husband was Levi Marion Hedges, a brother to my father, Peter Thompson Hedges.

My grandfather, Wm. Riblan Hedges, owned land on both sides of the Licking River, some of the land in Fleming Co. (now Rowan) and some in Bath County. The house "on the bank of the Licking River at the mouth of the Bluebank Creek" wear Farmers, Kentucky, was built on Grandfather's land, and was made a postoffice before I was grown. Grandfather (Wm. R. Hedges) and grandmother, Melinda R. (Cassity) Hedges, were buried near their home in Rowan Co., Ky. The village of Farmers was built on land purchased from Signed Add Hedges Broutlike Wm R Hedges, any grandfather

The following Bible record is that of the family of William Riblan Hedges, of Fleming Co., (later Rowan Co.), Kentucky, he being the son of Levi Hedges, born in Frederick Co., Maryland, and Levi in turn being the son of WILLIAM HEDGES, Jr., of the Revolution, (Lieutenant of the 4th Company, Christopher Stull, Capt., under the command of Col. Charles Beatty, of the 33rd Battalion, Maryland Militia). WILLIAM HEDGES, Jr. of the Revolution, died of smallpox, April or May, 1777, Frederick Co., Md., according to a statement of his grandson, Wm. Riblan Hedges, the man whose Bible record follows. WM. HEDGES, Jr.'s Will was made April 19, 1777, and probated May 6, 1777. In it he named wife, Elizabeth, and children: Andrew, John, William and Levi.

Wm. Riblan Hedges was a Captain of Militia of Kentucky, having been commissioned Captain in the 58th Regiment, 25th Brigade, July 23. 1832, when Thomas Metcalfe was Governor and John F. Macurdy was Secretary of State. The Bible first passed into the hands of Viana Jane, daughter of Wm. R. Hedges, and her daughter, Mary Samantha, wrote her name in the front of the Book. It next passed to her sister, Rosannah Sarah (Hedges) Gilkison, who gave it to Mattie Dell (Hedges) Horn, who left it by Will to her only living brother, Thaddeus Anlington Hedges. He, a minister of the Christian Church, and now hearing his 90th birthday, lent it to be photostated. He is 96 yrs. old 1 in 1955.



He was dextrous and worked as a blacksmith, tanner and carpenter, and of course, farmed, also. He sat on his porch the evening before his death, and watched the sun set, and sang his favorite song:

"The day is past and gone,
The evening shades appear;

"We lay our garments by

So death may soon disrobe us all
Of what we now possess."

He was taken suddenly in the nite by an attack of acute indigestion and was gone. Rosanah, his wife, was a midwife.

Doubtless there are many errors in the dates and names which follow, as Compiler has found differing dates for the same death in different Bibles of the same family. One gives the date the 21st and another gives the 23rd, and Compiler has no way of determining which is correct. Also, sometimes people make mistakes in their own data, and even the records of Courthouses have errors.

In the main, however, the people given in the pages which follow will be found to be those of the descendants of WILLIAM HEDGES, of the AMERICAN REVOLUTION and their spouses. Compiler has taken the trouble to hunt in Courthouses wherever she could, to find the dates and names, and gives them as found, or tells why they were incorrect wherever she can.

The genealogy is being compiled for printing at some future time, but Compiler submits this section of the genealogy so that many women and men will be able without further delay, to join the patriotic societies which require proof of descent for membership.

The record will be corrected and brot more up to date when opportunity offers to learn of errors and additions.

There may be more children in some families than those given in these pages. For instance, one member of the family knows of only one child for a given person, and informs Compiler that there was only one child; then later she learns that the individual in question was married a second time and had nine children by the second marriage. So these records show that there were certain children of certain people, tho there may be others not shown in these records. Compiler has included all that she found.
